	PHASE 1 (For Reference Only- Completed in Fall 2018) 291 S. Plymouth Ave is a 5k square foot 1880 brick structure that was most recently used as multiple offices, a workshop, and possibly an apartment. The parcel has been largely vacant and underutilized over the last period of ownership from the early 2000s to current. The parcel is unique in the fact that it sits just outside the Corn Hill preservation district and Rochester's Center City District. The existing structure was converted into 6 high efficiency market rate apartments highlighting & preserving the architecturally significant elements of the home, while adding locally sourced cabinetry, millwork, carpentry, and renovation services.
	PHASE 2 The remaining site is just large enough to construct three additional townhouses, each with 2-car garages. This portion would start in Spring 2020 and be completed by Fall 2020.

IX. FEES

1. Application Fee - Send with Completed Application

A non-refundable application fee of Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) shall be charged each applicant.

2. Administrative Fee - Paid at Closing

- (a) For tax-exempt IRB bond issues, the fee shall be one percent (1%) of the project amount. For projects that utilize a Payment In Lieu of Taxes (PILOT) agreement, an additional one-quarter percent (1/4%) will be added.
- (b) For lease/leaseback transactions and taxable bond issues, the fee shall be one-half percent (1/2%) of the project amount. For projects that utilize a Payment In Lieu of Taxes (PILOT) agreement, an additional one-quarter percent (1/4%) will be added.
- (c) For refunding outstanding COMIDA bond issues, the fee shall be one-quarter percent (1/4%) of the new issuance amount.
- 3. If a sales tax letter is required prior to closing, a non-refundable twenty-five percent (25%) of the Administrative Fee and Agency Counsel fee is payable at that time. This amount will be applied towards the Administrative fee and Agency Counsel Fee. The Sales Tax Letter shall only be for a three (3) month period. If the project does not have a formal closing within three (3) months of the sales tax letter being issued, and an extension is not granted, the balance of the Administrative fee and Agency Counsel fee become immediately due and payable.
- 4. Agency Counsel fee is one-third (1/3) of the Agency's Administrative fee, with a minimum fee for a lease/leaseback transaction of \$4,000.00.
- 5. Designated Bond Counsel fee is based on the complexity and amount of the transaction.
