	Workplace Interiors signed a lease for approximately 30,000 square feet of space at Carlson Park. The space consists of 12,000 sq ft for offices and 18,000 sq ft of warehouse. Per the terms of this lease, the tenant is responsible for complete renovation of the offices which haven't been occupied in almost 20 years. We are in the process of reviewing bids to select a contractor to complete the work.
	Workplace Interiors is an office furniture dealership that distributes office furniture and related services primarily in the Rochester market. We distribute furniture for major manufacturers in the industry, we do not manufacture anything.
	The company has experienced growth in the last few years. As a result, we have outgrown our current office (5,000 sq ft) facilities located in Fairport, and our warehouse (6,000 sq ft) located in East Rochester. Our search was for one facility that included office and warehouse. Our hope was to be centrally located to our customers within the city limits.
	The property we've chosen requires a complete renovation as the space has been vacant for approximately 10 years. The landlord was not willing to renovate the space themselves and in order to make the deal possible, we are responsible for the renovation from demolition to completion. The landlord's responsibility is minor in the whole scope of the project.
	This vacant building will be put to use as offices and showroom for our office furniture company. We will invest a considerable amount of money to improve the property and bring a vacant building within the city back to life.
