	Since 1998, Northern Air Systems (NAS) has been a leading provider of specialized cooling systems worldwide. With thousands of systems in operation today, NAS has the lowest downtime of any cooling system on the market. NAS has developed an integrated cooling system for many different industries, and is a trusted name for quality and dependability.
	NAS currently operates two facilities in Rochester, New York and another in Baton Rouge, Louisiana.  Anticipated industry expansion as well as new product lines has brought around the need for additional floorspace and employees to support continued growth. Areas in Texas and Baton Rouge have been considered for expansion, in addition to Rochester. NAS has decided to pursue expansion in Rochester as it would like to keep jobs and economic growth local.
	Current markets being served by NAS consist of Mobile Specialty Vehicles, Mobile Television Broadcast, Military & Homeland Security, Oil&Gas, Hazardous Locations, and Aviation. New markets are being pursued, such as Marine HVAC and new product lines, such as industrial size air handlers, are to be developed with the acquisition of additional floorspace and employees.
	The building that is being considered for purchase is located at 769 Trabold Road and will provide NAS with an additional 21,312 sq ft of manufacturing space and 4,448 sq ft of office space. It is located on 3.0 acres and is already approved for an additional 8,000 sq ft addition for continued growth. It has higher ceilings and door clearance, as well as a 10 ton overhead crane, that will accommodate the larger size units that will be built.
	In addition to the purchase of the building, over the next three years NAS will be investing in excess of \$1,000,000 for production machinery & equipment and building improvements. Job growth during this same period of time is forecasted to be in excess of 60 full time employees.

# IX. FEES

# 1. Application Fee - Send with Completed Application

A non-refundable application fee of Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) shall be charged each applicant.

# 2. Administrative Fee - Paid at Closing

- (a) For tax-exempt IRB bond issues, the fee shall be one percent (1%) of the project amount. For projects that utilize a Payment In Lieu of Taxes (PILOT) agreement, an additional one-quarter percent (1/4%) will be added.
- (b) For lease/leaseback transactions and taxable bond issues, the fee shall be one-half percent (1/2%) of the project amount. For projects that utilize a Payment In Lieu of Taxes (PILOT) agreement, an additional one-quarter percent (1/4%) will be added.
- (c) For refunding outstanding COMIDA bond issues, the fee shall be one-quarter percent (1/4%) of the new issuance amount.
- 3. If a sales tax letter is required prior to closing, a non-refundable twenty-five percent (25%) of the Administrative Fee and Agency Counsel fee is payable at that time. This amount will be applied towards the Administrative fee and Agency Counsel Fee. The Sales Tax Letter shall only be for a three (3) month period. If the project does not have a formal closing within three (3) months of the sales tax letter being issued, and an extension is not granted, the balance of the Administrative fee and Agency Counsel fee become immediately due and payable.
- 4. Agency Counsel fee is one-third (1/3) of the Agency's Administrative fee, with a minimum fee for a lease/leaseback transaction of \$4,000.00.
- 5. Designated Bond Counsel fee is based on the complexity and amount of the transaction.

## X. CERTIFICATION

- D. <u>Compliance with Applicable Laws:</u> The Applicant confirms and acknowledges that the owner, occupant, or operator receiving Financial Assistance for the proposed Project is in substantial compliance with applicable local, state and federal tax, worker protection and environmental laws, rules and regulations.
