	Bausch + Lomb is one of the oldest continually operating companies in the US today, tracing its roots to 1853, as a tiny optical goods shop in Rochester, New York. Bausch + Lomb has operated continuously in Rochester, NY since and has grown to become a global leader by providing innovative eye health products.
	This project will directly support Bausch + Lomb's strategic objective of improving peoples life through our health care products. It will enable expanded commercialization of novel silicone hydrogel contact lenses, providing innovation to the marketplace, while having a positive impact upon the local community,
	Specifically, this initiative entails the construction of an extension to Bausch + Lomb's Rochester, NY manufacturing facility. This building extension will house up to two lines of a new contact lens manufacturing platform. This project will result in 100 new personnel being hired.
	The building extension will be an estimated 110,000 to 120,000 square feet. Required services and facility infrastructure will be expanded to accommodate the new production lines. The new building is planned to incorporate energy improvements to energy efficiency and will be LEED Silver certified. The manufacturing lines will be of a new technology platform that will provide higher unit output and support production of novel silicone hydrogel contact lenses. The incremental personnel to be hired will include manufacturing, technical support, and administrative positions. These jobs will directly support the new technology manufacturing operation.

A non-refundable application fee of Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) shall be charged each applicant.

2. Administrative Fee - Paid at Closing

- (a) For tax-exempt IRB bond issues, the fee shall be one percent (1%) of the project amount. For projects that utilize a Payment In Lieu of Taxes (PILOT) agreement, an additional one-quarter percent (1/4%) will be added.
- (b) For lease/leaseback transactions and taxable bond issues, the fee shall be one-half percent (1/2%) of the project amount. For projects that utilize a Payment In Lieu of Taxes (PILOT) agreement, an additional one-quarter percent (1/4%) will be added.
- (c) For refunding outstanding COMIDA bond issues, the fee shall be one-quarter percent (1/4%) of the new issuance amount.
- 3. If a sales tax letter is required prior to closing, a non-refundable twenty-five percent (25%) of the Administrative Fee and Agency Counsel fee is payable at that time. This amount will be applied towards the Administrative fee and Agency Counsel Fee. The Sales Tax Letter shall only be for a three (3) month period. If the project does not have a formal closing within three (3) months of the sales tax letter being issued, and an extension is not granted, the balance of the Administrative fee and Agency Counsel fee become immediately due and payable.
- 4. Agency Counsel fee is one-third (1/3) of the Agency's Administrative fee, with a minimum fee for a lease/leaseback transaction of \$4,000.00.
- 5. Designated Bond Counsel fee is based on the complexity and amount of the transaction.
