4000 RIVER ROAD LLC, a New York limited liability company, or an entity formed or to be formed (collectively, the "Company") has requested that the Agency assist with a certain Project (the "Project"), consisting of: (A) the acquisition of a leasehold interest in an approximately 12.42-acre parcel of land located at 4000 East River Road in the Town of Henrietta, New York [Tax Map No.: 174.01-2-58.1] (the "Land") together with the existing 102-unit student housing apartment complex thereon known as Racquet Club Apartments (the "Existing Improvements"); (B)(i) the renovation and modernization of the Existing Improvements including, but not limited to, new kitchens/baths and full furnishings and (ii) the construction of an additional 3-story approximately 125,000 square-foot building with 81-units of additional student housing (the "Improvements"); and (C) the acquisition and installation therein, thereon or thereabout of certain machinery, equipment and related personal property (the "Equipment" and, together with the Land and the Improvements, the "Facility"); to serve the students of Rochester Institute of Technology. The Facility will be initially operated and/or managed by the Company.

The Agency will acquire a leasehold interest in the Facility and lease the Facility back to the Company. The Company will operate the Facility during the term of the lease. At the end of the lease term the Agency's leasehold interest will be terminated. The Agency contemplates that it will provide financial assistance (the "Financial Assistance") to the Company in the form of sales and use tax exemptions and a mortgage recording tax exemption, consistent with the policies of the Agency, and a partial real property tax abatement.

The Agency will, at the above-stated time and place, present a copy of the Company's Application (including the Benefit/Incentive analysis) and hear all persons with views in favor of or opposed to either the location or nature of the Facility, or the proposed financial assistance being contemplated by the Agency. In addition, at, or prior to, such hearing, interested parties may submit to the Agency written materials pertaining to such matters.
