The committee reviewed the funding request to approve the execution and delivery of a contract with the Greater Rochester Enterprise for the Economic Gardening program for \$50,000. Matt Hurlbutt, presented the request and discussed the program. After review and discussion, on motion by Z. Phillips, second by C. Johnston, all aye, the committee recommends the full board

approve the execution and delivery of a contract with the Greater Rochester Enterprise for the Economic Gardening program for one year, up to \$50,000.
