## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing pursuant to Article 18-A of the New York State General Municipal Law will be held by the County of Monroe Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") on Thursday, the 14<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2024 at 11:30 a.m., local time, in the Main Meeting Room at the Henrietta Town Hall, 475 Calkins Road, Henrietta, New York 14623, in connection with the following matter:

UNITHER MANUFACTURING LLC, a Delaware limited liability company for itself or a related entity formed or to be formed (collectively, the "Company") has requested that the Agency assist with a certain Project (the "Project"), consisting of: (A) the acquisition or retention of a leasehold interest in a portion of land located at 755 Jefferson Road in the Town of Henrietta, New York 14623 and all other lands in the Town of Henrietta where, by license or easement or other agreement, the Company or its designees are making improvements that benefit the Project (the "Land") together with the existing approximately 570,320 square foot building thereon (the "Existing Improvements"); (B) the construction of an approximately 65,000 square-foot addition to and retrofit of the Existing Improvements to host a new sterile manufacturing area, multiple new production lines for compounding, filling a state-of-the-art laboratory and warehouse (collectively, packaging, and the "Improvements"); and (C) the acquisition and installation therein, thereon or thereabout of certain machinery, equipment and related personal property (the "Equipment" and, together with the Land and the Improvements, the "Facility") to be used by the Company in its business of manufacturing pre-measured dosage forms for medications.

The Agency will acquire or retain a leasehold interest in the Facility and lease the Facility back to the Company. The Company will operate the Facility during the term of the lease. At the end of the lease term the Agency's leasehold interest will be terminated. The Agency contemplates that it will provide financial assistance (the "Financial Assistance") to the Company in the form of sales and use tax exemptions consistent with the policies of the Agency.

The Agency will, at the above-stated time and place, present a copy of the Company's Application and hear all persons with views in favor of or opposed to either the location or nature of the Facility, or the proposed financial assistance being contemplated by the Agency. In addition, at, or prior to, such hearing, interested parties may submit to the Agency written materials pertaining to such matters.
